

# Privacy Policy

## *Profile*

We store information that we collect through cookies, log files, clear gifs, and/or third party sources to create a “profile” of your preferences. We do not tie your personally identifiable information to information in the profile, in order to provide tailored promotions and marketing offers and to improve the content of the site for you.

We do not share your profile with other third parties.

## *Information Sharing and Disclosure*

*Aggregate Information (non-personally identifiable):*

We share aggregated demographic information about our user base with our partners and this information does not identify individual users.

We do not link aggregate user data with personally identifiable information.

*Personally identifiable information:*

Unless otherwise indicated, we do not share personally identifiable information with third parties.

## *Legal Disclaimer*

We reserve the right to disclose your personally identifiable information as required by law and when we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on our Web site.

## *Log Files*

As is true of most Web sites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.

We use this information, which does not identify individual users, to analyse trends, to administer the site, to track users' movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole.

We do not link this automatically-collected data to personally identifiable information.

We use a third-party tracking service that uses log files to track non-personally identifiable information about visitors to our site in the aggregate.

## *Cookies*

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use cookies on this site. We do not link the information we store in cookies to any personally identifiable information you submit while on our site.

We use session ID cookies. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. We do not use persistent cookies.

If you reject cookies, you may still use our site, but your ability to use some areas of our site, such as contests or surveys, will be limited.

Some of our business partners may use cookies on their sites. We have no access to or control over these cookies.
